BILL TAYLOR Economic Development Partnership of Alabama

Partnership of Alabama

Following a successful 38 year career in the automotive industry, Bill Taylor accepted a new role as President of the Economic Development Partnership of Alabama on July 1, 2009.

Prior to joining EDPA, Taylor was President and CEO of Mercedes-Benz U.S. International. A native of London, Ontario, Taylor came to Alabama when MBUSI located in the state in 1993. He was a key figure in the start-up of the new plant, led production for five years and became president of the company in 1999. Taylor was instrumental in the establishment of the Mercedes Production System, which is now a global standard for all Mercedes-Benz plants in achieving the highest levels of quality and efficiency.

Taylor oversaw the plant's \$600-million expansion, which was completed at the end of 2004, as well as the beginning of a \$300-million expansion underway to prepare for successor models. The plant employs more than 3,000 Team Members – significantly more than the 1,500 originally planned back in 1993. responsible for include alignment with the campus master plan, incorporating program/ user requirements, improving the living and learning environment for faculty and students, diminishing the impact of construction activities on the campus community, and providing projects that will provide the lowest overall lifecycle cost to the University.

He is a graduate of Purdue University with a degree in Construction Management.
